 To further help individuals who have suffered storm damage, the FEMA and IHSEM have established a Disaster Recovery Center in Scott County. This temporary office is designed to meet the needs of individuals in the areas affected by the severe storms, tornadoes and flooding beginning on May 25 and continuing. The location is Scott County Community College, Blong Technology Center located at 8500 Hillandale Road, Davenport. The hours are weekdays 8 a.m. to 7 p.m., Saturday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. and closed on Sundays. Phone lines are open 24 hours, seven days a week until further notice.

### YEAR OF PAUL:

#### PAUL'S MISSIONARY JOURNEYS

Paul is our most prolific epistle writer, with 13 letters found in the Bible. Some of these were written to the communities he established on his journeys to guide them in their struggles when he couldn't be with them..

He made three major missionary trips to preach the word and establish Christian communities. The first took him to the island of Cyprus, several cities in Asia Minor, back to Antioch, then to Jerusalem and back to Antioch. His second journey had him returning to Asia Minor to check up on the Christian communities he established there. On his third major journey he went north to Galatia and Phrygia crossing over to Europe for the first time, preaching in Macedonia and the Greek cities of Phillipi, Thessalonica, Beorea, Athens, and Corinth. Eventually he preached in Ephesus, the most important city in Asia Minor.

You'll find a variety of topics about the only saint whose feast date on the Church calendar commemorates his conversion date rather than the date of his death.
