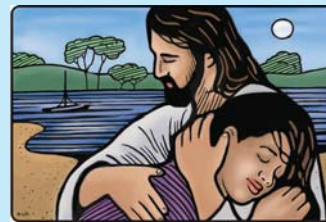

**Acting for Justice**

*"Home"work*

**July 6, 2008**

*The Grandparents of the Lord*

Be sure to show your love to your grandparents on the day we remember the grandparents of Jesus. The gospels don't tell us about Mary's parents, but they do tell us Joseph's father's name. In fact, we're given two names! The gospel of Luke says Joseph was "son of Heli" (3:23). The gospel of Matthew says "Jacob was the father of Joseph the husband of Mary, of whom Jesus was born" (1:16).

Ancient writers provided names for the unnamed characters in the gospels. The centurion at Jesus' crucifixion was called Longinus, meaning "lance". The "good thief" who was crucified with Jesus was named Dismas, meaning "one who was dying." The Samaritan woman at the well was called Photina, meaning "enlightened."

Mary's parents were named Anne and Joachim. "Anne" means "gracious" and "Joachim" means "God raises him." Your own name probably has a meaning. It's worth learning and perhaps living up to!

Most names have variations. Some variations on Anne are Ann, Annette, Ana, Anita, Anna, Anika and Hannah. Legends about Saint Anne are a lot like the Bible's stories of Hannah, the mother of the prophet Samuel. These stories are found in the first few chapters of the First Book of Samuel.

Another biblical Anne is the prophet Anna, who spoke about the infant Jesus to all who were waiting for God to bring justice to the world. Read about her in Luke 2:36-38.

Throughout this month, let's celebrate **our** saint, St. Ann. And also our grandparents and all those who have helped us grow in our faith as individuals and a community of believers.
