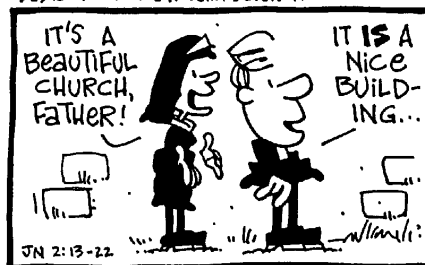

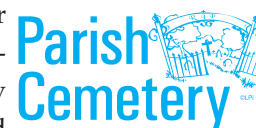

We have received 124 ADA pledges back totaling \$31,185 so far. We have received 151 pledges for our general operating fund for a total of \$291,564. Thanks to those who have responded! We believe that with a response of about 175 more of you, we can meet or exceed our budget needs for these obligations. Our monthly payment for the ADA is \$5,000. In October we only received \$3,900. We had to take \$1,100 out of the general fund.
