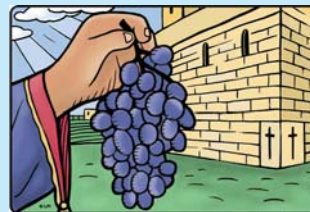

Adult: Name a time when you saw God present in your life this past week?

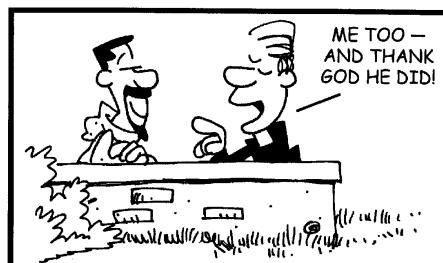
