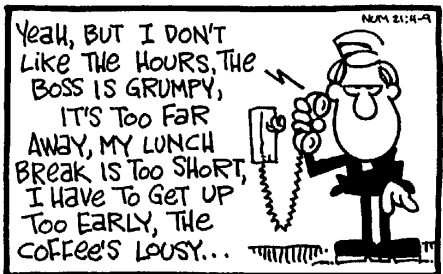

# The Adult Corner September 14, 2008

**What's So Ordinary about Ordinary Time?** Ordinary Time is more precisely "ordinal" time—counted time, numbered days, counting down the time until Christ returns in glory. Ordinary Time can be divided into seasonal times, with the lectionary presenting different scriptural themes and images during each. Right now we are completing the Summer Ordinary Time with parables of farming and harvesting. In the Fall Ordinary Time the readings become apocalyptic, leading us into Advent's eschatology. After Christmas, we'll get into the motif of the growing light that Christmas introduced. Next week, look for a section defining church terms such as those used in this article.
