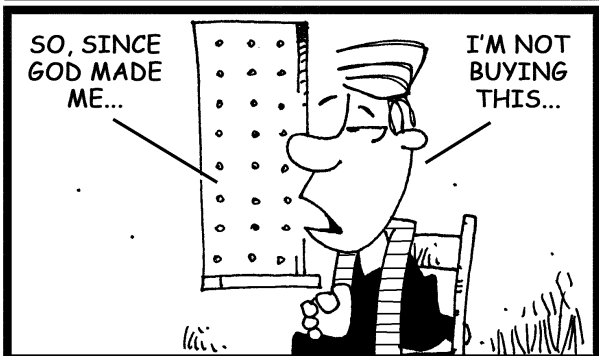
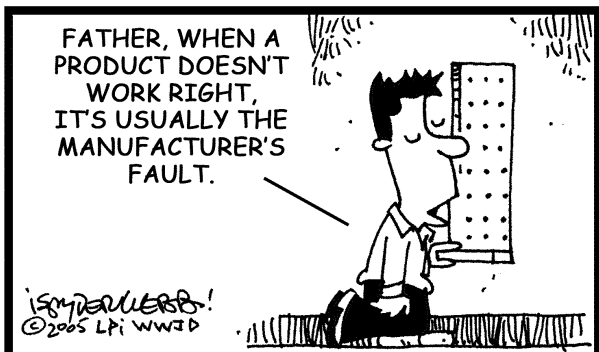
Benedictine Live-In Weekend
