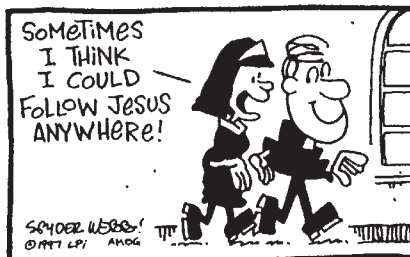
**North Scott Food Pantry Needs**
