1. Grounds

A. Bill notified Joe that the 425 Lawn mower may have an ignition problem.

B. Joe reviewed and commented on the following items:

- Parish is in the process of buying new stations of the cross, material will be acrylic or metal. The existing stations of the cross are beyond repair
- Paver block walkway is needed at the south entry of the classroom building to eliminate the need for users to walk through mud or over wooden plank, plywood.
- Would like to see an Architectural Block retaining wall constructed at the perimeter of the storm sewer inlet, located southwest of the double door entry into the new addition, to reduce the amount of sediment entering the inlet.
- Sanitary sewer, serving the kitchen restroom, froze up again this spring, this seems to happen every time the frost comes out of the ground. Some possible causes are the low slope the pipe has been laid, low flow of fluids through the pipe, burial depth. Ploog Plumbing has been asked to review the problem; one solution may be to tie the line into the rectory septic tank, located north of the kitchen.
- Notified Scott that he did not want any notices put in the Sunday bulletin at this time regarding donation of trees to replace those removed along St. Ann's Road last summer due to storm damage.
- Expressed his opinion that the yews, located at the base of the cemetery cross, should remain for now.
- He will notify Scott if he will require additional help to spread the remaining mulch.

C. Matt reported that he will try to grind out the tree stumps located in the west wind break sometime this summer as he feels like the stumps will be dried out enough.

D. Scott notified Joe that he had looked at the Banner support foundation located along St. Ann's Road and found it to be stable.
