

St. Ann's Building & Grounds Commission Meeting
October 14, 2008

1. Grounds

A. Scott gave the following update on the shrine restoration

- Stone work completed week of 10/13/08
- Saturday 10/18/08 plants, mulch work west elevation will be completed, railings reinstalled, upper level seeded down
- John Zrostlik, Eagle Scout candidate, has indicated that he would like to complete Phase II of the shrine restoration project for his Eagle Scout project. Work would include cleaning, restoration, repainting of bench and statues, base for bench and statues, and possible additional landscaping at the upper level
- Attendees reviewed the possibility of reconstructing the walkway to the shrine in the future, as the existing concrete sidewalk is breaking up. In lieu of a concrete sidewalk, a brick paver or stone walkway was discussed. If a concrete walk is reinstalled we may want to consider a narrower walk or a winding walkway.

B. Scott reported on the following:

- Campfire wood has been removed from the grounds
- The majority of the tree stumps in the west wind break have been ground down. Approximately four (4) stumps remain.

C. Paul reported that it was discussed in the Parish Council meeting that a parish member is willing to trim the dead tree branch, located north of the church. He did not remember the name of the individual.

D. List of projects the Buildings & Grounds Commission may work on during the year 2009:

- Concrete block retaining wall, at ground mounted HVAC equipment, west elevation, classroom wiring
- Trim hedges perimeter of parish rental home
- Walkway to south entrance, classroom wing

2. Buildings

A. Paul noted that he would like to see the wood trim pc. choir stair riser removed and replaced with a low profile trim pc. Due to the existing pc. being a tripping hazard.

3. Misc.

A. Buildings & Grounds will host the March 2009 parish breakfast, date to be determined. Bill suggested that a French toast casserole menu be considered.
