 - Building & Grounds: Meeting on 10/11. Property winterization underway. Grotto ceiling painting and electrical outlet installation scheduled. Also an outdoor portable stage is being contemplated (Eagle Scout project) for use in outdoor ceremonies. Youth lounge: final plans still in negotiation with the county building inspector. HVAC efficiency testing being done by TMI. Life/Family Life: Rita P. made calls to members of the Commission to determine future interest and meetings. Angel Tree gifts are a project of this commission in the past. Rita will contact Joyce Kloft to see how she can support it.
 - Liturgy: 9/29 Meeting, with minutes provided. Matt Wilson, chairman, Diana Vollbeer, Secretary. Next meeting set for 11/17. Purpose of the commission discussed. Focus of the meeting was primarily on the New Roman Missal, and the possibilities that it provides to deepen the faith of the parishioners. Catechesis of the parish will continue. New musical mass parts will be introduced in masses later in October so that the congregation will be familiar prior to Advent, when the full implementation starts. Mass times for holy days for the rest of the calendar year, the Christmas season have been set. Confirmation, Easter and Graduation dates and times have also been set.
 - Stewardship: First meeting on 10/25.
 - Finance: Annual Diocesan Appeal/Parish Commitment campaign is this weekend (10/15-16). Diocese had asked to retake control of the ADA, but we will continue to manage it at our parish level. Msgr distributed and summarized the handout that parishioners will receive regarding budgetary needs.
 - Faith Formation: Met on 10/5. Will meet 1st Wednesday of each month. Discussed state of faith formation attendance. Several events are planned for youth groups (retreats, NCYC, mission trips). FF Commission needs communication from the youth representatives to help the adults know their spiritual needs. The importance of communicating parental responsibilities for
