

St. Ann's Parish Council Minutes  
September 9, 2008

1. Meeting was called to order by President Melissa Brimeyer at 7:00 PM.
  - 1.1 Opening prayer was led by Father Parlette.
  - 1.2 Roll call was taken by Secretary Inez Tobin.
  - 1.3 Agenda was adopted as written.
  - 1.4 Minutes from the July meeting were approved by council.
2. Special Presentations
  - 2.1 The golf outing on September 14<sup>th</sup> was discussed. \$792 will be donated to the food pantry from the entries. All spots are filled. There is also several nice donations to be used as prizes and for a raffle. Raffle tickets are going to be sold at Rustic Ridge and all parishioners are invited to come and bid on any donated items included in the raffle. All money collected will go to the food pantry.
  - 2.2 Father informed the council that no parish nurse volunteer has come forth yet. Anyone interested should contact the church office.
  - 2.3 Commission Reports.
    - a. Faith Formation – Religious Ed classes start on September 14 for Pre K thru 6<sup>th</sup> grade. There is still a need for a 3<sup>rd</sup> grade catechist. Several volunteers are needed as well as catechists for junior high and high school. Junior high and high school classes start on September 17.
    - b. Liturgy – Reminders will be put in the bulletin about what changes there has been in the mass and the why. This is to update people on new practices taking place.
    - c. Church Life/Family Life – Breakfast went well with \$378 being made. Golf outing was discussed and everything was on track for this event. Christy was still out getting more prizes and raffle items.
    - d. Social Action – No report
    - e. Building & Grounds – A workday is set for September 27<sup>th</sup> for volunteers to help install the Stations of the Cross, painting, yard work and other maintenance. Several scouts have been doing projects for St. Ann's grounds. These include the flag pole, fire ring, Fatima Shrine, footings for stations, and the St. Ann sign at church entrance. A letter will be sent to parishioners for donations concerning some of these projects. Joe noted that Scott Youngbauer has spent many extra hours on this committee and commended him for his invaluable service.
    - f. Stewardship – A book sale is set for November 30<sup>th</sup> and December 7<sup>th</sup>. The books sold will be religious books of interest. If you know of some book that would be of interest to someone else you may let Bill Briggs know so it could be shared with others.
    - g. Finance – The budget for next year was presented and discussed by the council. The budget will be presented to parishioners sometime in October. Budget was approved by council.
