4)	<p>Kiosk discussion: The theme for the July kiosk is: "Stewardship of Your God Given Body".</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Ken provided a document on St. Blasé that explains his background and why he is a Saint. - Glenn provided scripture and weblinks on health. - Glenn informed us that we need to determine what we want on the Kiosk with regards to races, runs, bicycling and other healthy events as there are more than we can post. We decide the local events would be the focus. - Glenn noted that October is Respect Life Month, so it could expand on the Gift of Life theme in October. - Ken suggested that we discuss with Ann Mohr the making of a virtual kiosk on the website that allows folks to have access to more information than what you can normally find on the kiosk. - Joanne was not present but called Bill to inform him that she has: A Mental Health Quiz, Flyers on Mental Health and a calendar showing healthy activities that she will provide for the kiosk display. - Maggie was checking with the Parish Nurse for information on: Nutrition, Diet, Health information and services provided by the Nurse. - The Blood Drive at St. Ann's is the 26th of June but we will post general information on giving blood and the donation site location. 	<p>The work on putting together the kiosk display will be on the 30th of June.</p> <p>Ken will consolidate the information on Saint Blasé in to a one page document.</p> <p>Glenn will consolidate the health information weblinks in to a format the will be provided in the take-away pouch.</p> <p>Bill will take the scripture Glenn provided and change the font size for better reading on the kiosk.</p> <p>Bill & Glenn notified Erika Mildred of the virtual kiosk website idea and she is going to share the idea with Ann Mohr when she returns from the mission trip.</p> <p>Maggie will provide information from the Parish Nurse, about health related topics, nutrition pyramid, and other health related information as well as services.</p> <p>Glenn will provide details on The Moonlight Chase (July), Relay for Life (cancer walk), Crop Walk (Sept./Oct.) & Others. (See Ann Mohr for CROP Walk)</p> <p>Joanne Hermiston provided information on Mental Health.</p> <p>Julie has located the materials for the background and border of the kiosk display.</p>
